

## NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

On January 6, 2012, Dougherty County, Georgia and the Dougherty County School System submitted a Redistricting/Reapportionment Plan to the United States Department of Justice asking for preclearance under Section 5 of the Voting Rights Act of 1965 of said Plan as adopted by the Georgia General Assembly on August 25, 2011 and approved by the Governor of the State of Georgia on September 21, 2011. The Redistricting/Reapportionment Plan as applied to election districts of the Board of Commissioners of Dougherty County, Georgia and the Dougherty County School Board provided for the changing of district lines among the single member districts for both County Commission elected officials and School Board elected officials in order to comply with "one person one vote" based on the 2010 official census. The sixty (60) day period shall commence upon receipt of the submission by the Voting Section of the Department of Justice Civil Rights Division. The joint Dougherty County, Georgia and Dougherty County School System submission was mailed to the Chief of the Voting Section of the Civil Rights Division of the United States Department of Justice by Federal Express, U.S. Airbill on January 6, 2012.
