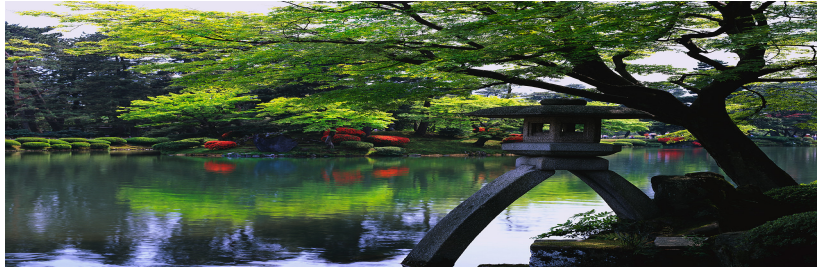


# RIVERFRONT PARK



## RIVERFRONT PARK GENERAL INFORMATION

RiverFront Park located on Front Street in Downtown Albany is an interactive park comprised of many features: Turtle Grove Park, Festival Springs Fountain, the Bridge House, Horace King Overlook and the River Walk.

The Director of Facilities Management is responsible for maintenance of RiverFront Park which is a Dougherty County owned public property. As such, all laws and ordinances governing the use of such public property apply. All requests for park usage must be completed at least 60 days prior to the intended use for large events (festivals, class/family reunions, celebrations, concerts, etc.)

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

**HOURS OF OPERATION:** Daily, 9:00 am-Sunset unless permit is obtained.

**FESTIVAL SPRINGS FOUNTAIN:** Regulations posted at the fountain

**AMPLIFIED MUSIC/PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEMS:** By permit only. Volume of hand carried radios must not disturb others.

**ANIMALS:** Dogs on leashes on Riverwalks only.

**COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES:** By permit only.

**FISHING:** Permitted under DNR Rules and Regulations

**MOTORIZED VEHICLES:** Persons with disabilities only.
